

RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MEMBERS

(By-Law 5 of the Internal Rules)

1. The Full Members have the following rights:

- (a) to attend the assembly of the General Meeting with the power as foreseen in Article 8 of the Statutes;
- (b) to vote in accordance with the terms and conditions defined in Articles 10.2 to 10.5, 11.1 and 12 of the Statutes;
- (c) to nominate and dismiss members of the Board of Directors according to Article 8.3 of the Statutes;
- (d) to nominate members as meant in Article 5 of the Statutes;
- (e) to receive the material, information and various services which AMASC provides;
- (f) to speak at the assembly of the General Meeting.

2. The Full Members have the following duties:

- (a) to contribute effectively toward the realisation of the objects and activities of AMASC as formulated in Article 3 of the Statutes;
- (b) to encourage the personal involvement of members of their national associations in the work of AMASC;
- (c) to conform in so far as possible the statutes and by-laws of their national associations to the general form of the Statutes and By-Laws of AMASC;
- (d) to send representatives to the assemblies of the General Meeting;
- (e) to pay regular contributions to AMASC as required by Article 7 of the Statutes and specified in By-Law 15 of these By-Laws.
- (f) to keep AMASC informed of the activities of their national associations and in particular to present an annual report of these activities to AMASC.
